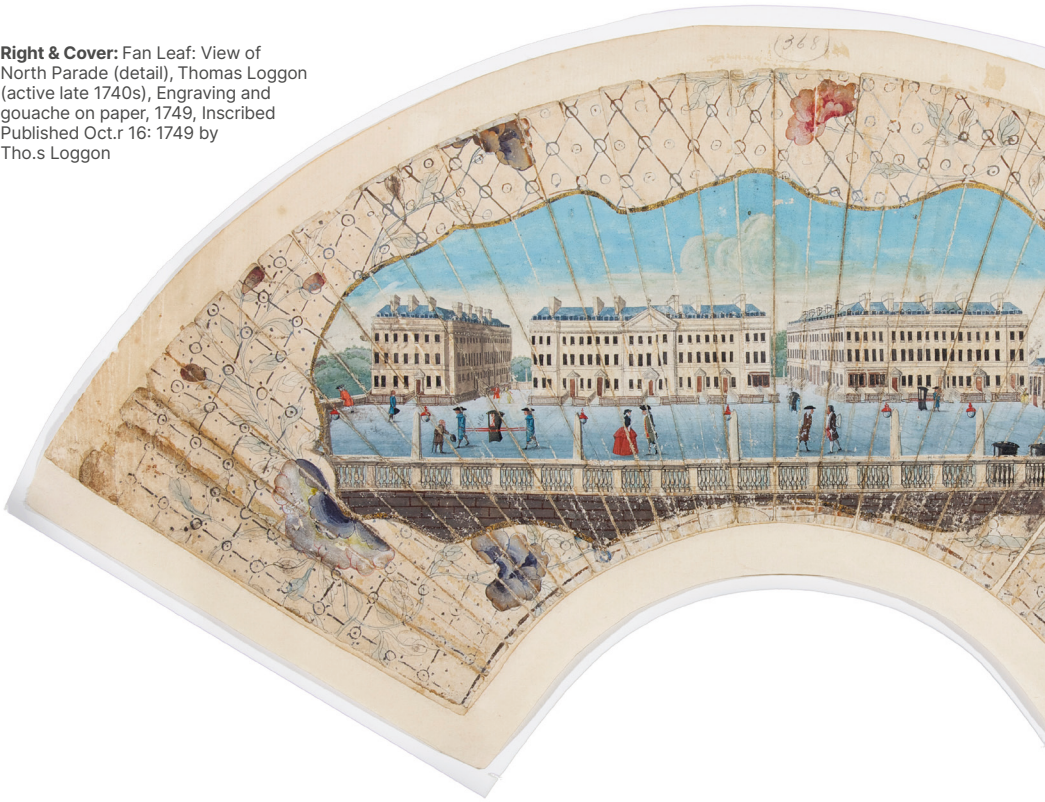
## Director's Circle
