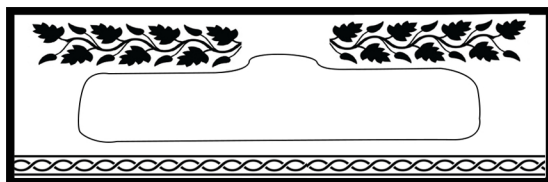


Design A Mythological Creature

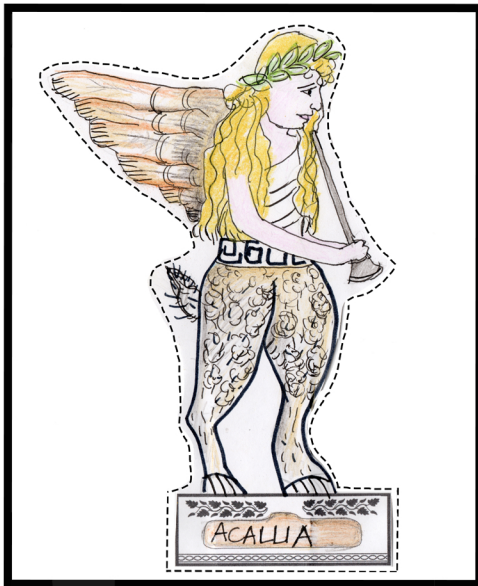

Don't forget to write your creature's name in the plaque!

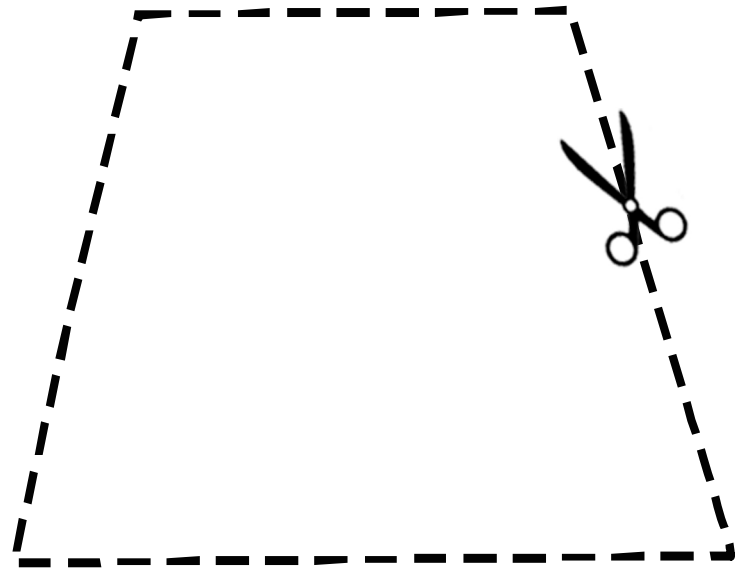

Carefully cut out a rough shape around your character.



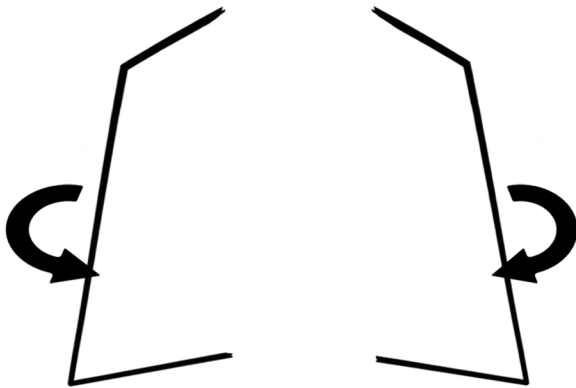

Cut out your creature's stand by cutting along the dotted line.



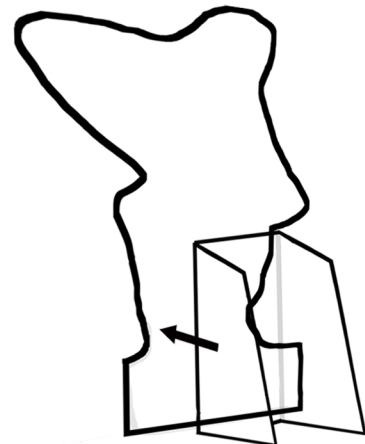

Turn your creature around so that the design is facing away from you. Glue the middle rectangle section of your stand to the back of your creature.
